

Here is a list of services we can provide to Northern College students who <u>do not</u> have a local primary care provider.

Nursing appointments are booked Monday to Friday.

- Immunizations and TB skin tests (<u>students</u> <u>must present their yellow immunization</u> <u>and Ontario Health cards</u>
- Injections: B12, Depo, allergy shots (with a primary care provider order)
- Blood pressure checks
- Dressing changes
- Suture/Staple removal *(with a primary care provider order)*
- Ear flushing

Nurse Practitioner appointments are booked on Thursday evenings.

Please contact our clinic to book an appointment for episodic health concerns such as sore throat, pregnancy test, UTI, ear infections, pap tests, and some medication renewals or to authorize Health Records when indicated.

If you are a Northern College student who does not have a local primary care provider, contact our clinic for more information or to schedule an appointment with the Nurses or Nurse Practitioner.

<u>Your student ID must be presented in</u> <u>order to book an appointment.</u>

Be prepared

If a health care provider signature is required on any documentation, you <u>must</u> ensure your portions of the form are complete <u>before</u> seeing the Nurse Practitioner.

Check with your program coordinator to confirm you have all the documentation to fulfil your program requirements.

Students can have blood work done at our clinic with an authorized Ministry of Health lab requisition and a valid health card. Blood work clinics are held:
